TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: "It's hard to analyze a game because you're not really paying attention to who they have in the game. And I'm sure that some of the players they had in the game at one point won't be playing there a long time. It's hard to judge until we look at the film."

"The things that you could see were Morton running the football and bouncing off of people and I thought Golsteyn through the ball well. Doug had to scramble and did an excellent job."

"For a preseason game it was a very good game for us. I think we got everybody in we could in. We got in three tight ends and all our offensive linemen played except Steve Wilson (ankle injury). We played all the linebackers and all the secondary and they gotbanged up.

"The only penalty that really hurt was the holding on the punt. They got a first down and went in to score. In fact in that drive we also had a pass interception dropped. Some of the penalties were caused by overeagerness. If they continue to happen the people who make them won't be here."

"I thought Booker played long and well. If we can get Booker to keep his shirt in we'll be okay."

(Jeff Davis) "The first time he touched a ball in a professional game he ran it in for a touchdown. The only other guy I know who did that was Red Grange. I told the players that and they didn't remember Red Grange. He's a good linebacker but there are things he has to learn. That's the kind of game he has to be in and he played quite a bit and that's good. David McNeel played in there quite a bit and he did well."

PHILADELPHIA COACH DICK VERMEIL: (On Joe Pisarcik) "Joe was knocked out and taken to a hospital here for observation (St. Joseph's Hospital, he regained consciousness before being taken from the stadium and being taken to the hospital was described as a "precaution")

(Pisarcik's performance a cause for worry) : "No, it just proves he's human like Jaworski is when he plays all the time."

(the Bucs): "I thought they were much better tonight then we were. They were better prepared to play a preseason game then we were and at the end it was just a physical mismatch."

(things degenerated at the end) : "That doesn't bother me. TheBucs were playing against people who will be home on Monday."

(first team) : "I wasn't totally satisfied. With our approach we went in to the game with a limited offense, very basic so everyone could play. I thought we didn't show any improvement in nastiness and all of the good hits came from the Buccaneers defense. I thought offensively we were a little surprised however we did have some nice drives.

(on Colzie's interception): "They tripped him (Oliver). He was on the ground and Colzie was the only one Joe saw. The ref just didn't see the trip and Joe came out looking bad on that play."

"We had some breakdowns by people who shouldn't make mistakes like a starting guard one time."

Coach McKay told me before I went in that I was going to run an outside play which is what I wanted.

(did you think you would do that well) "It was probably the last thing in the world. All I wanted to do was execute and not make mistakes. On the long run I got a good block by Tony Davis. They said if I made the team it would be as a running back first and then as a kick returner.

Jeff Davis, linebacker - "I made some mistakes. Once I got the interception it got the others going. If I can get in there and do it, so can they."

Scoring the touchdown was one of my greatest experiences in football especially with everyone saying I'm too short."

Melvin Carver, running back - "It felt good to both do well coming from the same school (UNLV). I wanted to try and do everything well. I was more relaxed after carrying the football once because then it was just football. I still I have a lot to prove to myself and the coaches.

White played three seasons for the Bucs from 1977-79. Jordan was with the Bucs from 1976 when he was Tampa Bay's sixth-round draft choice until last fall when he was claimed by Washington on procedural recall waivers. Puetz played 10 games for the Buccaneers in 1978.
