ATLANTA COACH LEEMAN BENNETT: "We got beat by a football tonight that was much prepared and played a much better football game than we did. I thought they dominated us on the line of scrimmage both offensively and defensively. It looked to me like Tampa Bay's off to another good year.

(surprised by offensive lines off performance) I certainly was. Their offensive line beat our offensive line all the way across the line of scrimmage."

(tougher cuts after tonight) "I don't know that it makes a lot of difference either way. You have to go back and look at the film and see who did what as far as cuts are concerned. I haven't talked to the doctors yet but I think we came out of the game in pretty good shape injurywise."

(the slow performance) "I expected us to have some life tonight and play a much better ballgame than we played. I talked all week long in terms of this being a final tuneup. Even though we weren't going to play our veterans about a half we expected them to be a little bit sharper than they were. We played without enthusiasm. We didn't play well at all."

(two flat games in four) "It very definitely has to be somewhat of a concern. By the same token I feel like we've accomplished generally what we want to accomplish in training camp. Naturally we would have like to have been 4-0 and not have these ballgames where we got beat. We would rather have lost by a point or two than be embarrassed."

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: "We played a spasmodic game but we played very aggressive and that's what the game is all about."

(quarterbacks - were they played one, two, three?) "As you saw them tonight." Basically Williams and Golsteyn did a good job."

(midseason form) "That's a good term, midseason form. I think in midseason last year we lost every game."

(Melontree) "Anytime a linebacker blitzes and anybody screws up, he's going to look awfully good. We'll have to look at the pictures and see what he had to take."

(end of preseason) "It is always better to win than to lose. I don't think they ever did get in field goal range (Atlanta crossed midfield once in 12 possessions. Their closest penetration was to the Tampa Bay 44)
